Irrigation Project Update

MetroWest Master Association is well into the highly anticipated upgrade of the irrigation system for MetroWest Communities. The first division to experience the benefits of the \$1.6 million project was Westpointe Boulevard, where the irrigation system can now be regulated through computer systems down organized water pathways.

At this time, installation of the upgraded irrigation has continued to MetroWest Boulevard. During the irrigation upgrade process, Newburg Irrigation personnel and vehicles will be noticeably in the community digging, boring and installing new equipment along specific business and residential property lines.

In some cases they may be directly facing specific easements along pathways. If there are lines within easements along roadway that may belong to specific owners, please contact MWMA at 407-601-5995 to communicate this as soon as possible.

MWMA is seeking the least disruptive measures to complete this new, state-of-the-art irrigation system replacement of the previous system, which was nearly 30 years old.

Patience is asked for as this upgrade is completed. MWMA is striving to ensure the impact to commutes will be minimal, and is assured, the final impact to the community will be substantial.
