Orlando Health Presents Second Annual MetroWest MusicWORKS Event July 4

*Free Event Will Feature Fireworks and Live Tribute Performances by
Elton Jonathan and Get Ready*



ORLANDO, Fla. (May 4, 2020) – Presented by Orlando Health, the second annual MetroWest MusicWORKS will take place Monday, July 4, from 6-10 p.m. at the MetroWest Golf Club, 2100 S Hiawassee Road, Orlando, FL 32835.

Staged by the MetroWest Master Association, MetroWest MusicWORKS is a free community event featuring music and fireworks. MusicWORKS also will offer a variety of dining options from several food trucks as well as adult beverages for sale.

The entertainment lineup for MusicWORKS features tribute bands honoring the magic of both Motown and Elton John.

Get Ready, a tribute act to Motown super groups The Temptations and The Four Tops, will perform at 6:15 p.m. The Temptations' timeless hits include "My Girl," "Ain't Too Proud To Beg," "The Way You Do The Things You Do," and "Get Ready." The Four Tops are famous for enduring hits such as "I Can't Help Myself (Sugar Pie Honey Bunch)," "It's The Same Old Song," "Reach Out I'll Be There," and "Baby I Need Your Loving." Get Ready's collective talent includes fine vocals, precise moves and a variety of lead vocal performances.

MetroWest will celebrate America's birthday "Philadelphia Freedom"-style with Elton Jonathan: a tribute to Elton John. The MusicWORKS headline act will perform at 7:15 p.m. and 8:15 p.m., bringing to life the music of one of the best-selling artists of all time – Sir Elton John. From his first U.S. hit, "Your Song," to such iconic chart-toppers as "Tiny Dancer," "I'm Still Standing," and "Crocodile Rock," Elton Jonathan delivers Elton John's classic songs to the delight of fans everywhere.

Starting at 9:30 p.m., the 20-minute fireworks show at the end of MusicWORKS will be staged by Pyro Shows, a 50-year-old pyrotechnic company headquartered in Tennessee.

Attendees should bring chairs or blankets. Coolers and pets are prohibited. No public entry will be allowed before 4 p.m. MusicWORKS is a rain or shine event, except in the case of extreme weather.

Offsite parking only will be available at Valencia College in MetroWest. Shuttle service to and from MetroWest Golf Club will be provided.
