## **Fifth Annual MetroWest MusicWORKS Draws 10,000 Attendees**

*Free Event Featured Fireworks, Skydiving and Tribute to American Blues*



ORLANDO, Fla. (July 5, 2023) – An estimated crowd of more than 10,000 attendees enjoyed an evening of music, food and fireworks at the MetroWest MusicWORKS event July 2 at MetroWest Golf Club.

“We are very pleased that so many people joined us to celebrate Independence Day,” said Julie Sanchez, MWMA General Manager. “MusicWORKS is one aspect of what makes MetroWest such a great place to live, work, play and connect.”

MusicWORKS offered food trucks, rides, vendors, live musical performances, a skydiving spectacular honoring the armed forces, and an exciting fireworks show.

Staged by the MetroWest Master Association (MWMA), the free, public event featured accomplished musicians Will Donato, Matt Marshak, Jeff Kashiwa, JJ Sansaverino, Khristian Dentley and Charlyce Simmons performing “Red White & Blues – a Tribute to American Blues.”

Another highlight was Team Fastrax, the largest professional skydiving team in the world, diving into the event with a 2,000-square-foot American flag. Team Fastrax dedicates every performance to a fallen hero, carrying with them an American flag that will be presented to that hero’s family. The MusicWORKS performance was dedicated to Marine Lance Cpl. Charles S. Sharp, who died July 2, 2009 while serving during Operation Enduring Freedom.

The amazing 20-minute fireworks show that concluded MusicWORKS 2023 was staged by Pyro Shows, a 50-year-old pyrotechnic company headquartered in Tennessee.

During MusicWORKS, MWMA presented representatives from Westpointe Elementary and MetroWest Elementary each with checks for \$5,000, donations MWMA makes annually.
