Attendees should bring chairs or blankets. Personal fireworks, coolers and pets are strictly prohibited. No public entry will be allowed before 4 p.m. MusicWORKS is a rain or shine event, except in the case of extreme weather.

Offsite parking only will be available off Metrocenter Boulevard in MetroWest. Shuttle service to and from MetroWest Golf Club will be provided.
