 Bicycles and valuable items left in the yard can quickly disappear.
- **LIGHT IT** Well-lit properties are far less likely to be broken into as light is a huge deterrent to criminals. Set timers for your interior lights at home as well; criminals prefer vacant properties to break into rather than occupied.
- **CONNECT G**et to know your neighbors. If you look out for them, they will look out for you.


