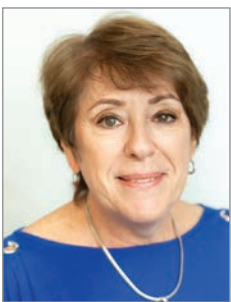
Monica Luiza F. El Rassy, *Treasurer, Stonebridge Lakes*
